Note: You have to have TestFlight installed on your device

How long does it take to publish your production version in App Store - As of 2019, average

app review time is "about a day"; used to be days or even weeks

2. Google Play - Android Only


Alpha Test on Google Play

- Up to 100 internal testers
- Testers are invited via gmail or a public link

Note: More than one version of the same app cannot be tested at the same

time; you have to leave the test program in order to download a production

version



P.S. Publishing an Android app in Google Play takes about an hour or two; sometimes even faster.

<u>HockeyApp</u> - from November 16, 2019 is <u>AppCenter</u> by Microsoft Visual Studio. A cross-platform distribution solution

<u>Firebase App Distribution</u> - formerly Crashlytics (from Fabric). A cross-platform distribution solution. <u>Demo Video</u>

TestFairy - a cross-platform solution that support iOS, Android, Xamarin, React Native, Cordova applications. <u>TestFairy Demo Video</u>
